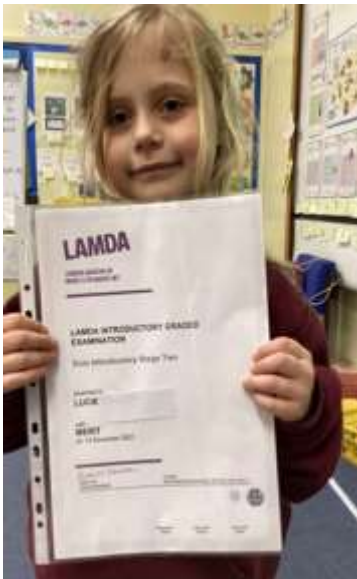
World Book Day Celebrations
