

User guide for IDL Maths

Getting Started

- 1. Go to idlsgroup.com
- 2. Press 'My IDL Login' and log in using your child's details which you will be given to you by their class teacher
- 3. Press the green Numeracy box to go onto the Maths programme.
- 4. It will ask your child to complete a test so that it can set them to the correct level on the programme. Press the orange schedule test button and your child can work through the test.
- 5. It is best for your child to complete the test completely independently so that the programme sets them to the right place for their next steps in their Maths Learning.
- 6. The test can take a little bit of time to complete so it is fine to do some and then log out and go back to it. The programme will start you off at the place that you left it.
- 7. Once the test is completed, the programme is set up and ready to use.



Using IDL Maths

Once the test is completed, your child will have their own personalised account set up and ready to use. Log into IDL in the same way and select Numeracy.

This time there will be a green box saying lesson and a number. Click on that box and work through the lessons.

Continue to do that working through the lessons.

You can help your child when they are working through the lessons and some children will need support to use IDL Maths.

Children can use number lines, counters or any other resources to help them when they are working through the lessons.

We would recommend spending 15-30 minutes at a time working on IDL Maths 3-5 times a week. However, any time spent using the programme will be beneficial.
