Get in control of parental controls

- If using a smartphone, check adult bar is set
- Set parental controls on your home broadband
- Control app downloads and purchases
- Make the games console safe and secure
- Use safety mode on YouTube and Google
- If using social networks, check privacy settings

Managing privacy settings on apps

Despite having minimum age requirements, over half of primary school children aged 7 - 11 have profiles on social networking sites.

If your child is using these networking sites and respective apps, please check the minimum age. If they do not meet the minimum age requirement, they should not be using them.
