- Set parental controls on your home broadband
- Control app downloads and purchases
- Make the games console safe and secure
- Use safety mode on YouTube and Google
- If using social networks, check privacy settings

Managing privacy settings on apps

Despite having minimum age requirements, over half of primary school children aged 7-11 have profiles on social networking sites.
