New to you Toys

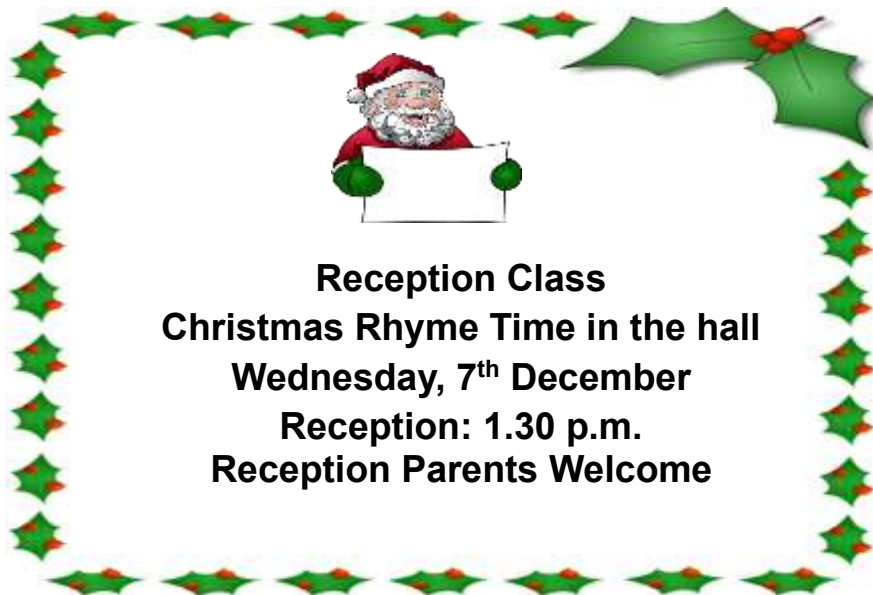
